This service is for LSC contracted providers who deliver all forms of Work Based Learners including E2E, Apprenticeships and Train to Gain.

What service is available to you?

All Work Based Learning (WBL) providers can enjoy access to information and resources, join forums to share effective practice and participate in a wide range of RSC Northern events.

- Interactive learning - a varied and interactive learning programme can engage learners better and so lead to improved retention and achievement.

- Easily accessible information - the provision of easily accessible information on progression routes relevant to your learners.
- Networking with other providers - a series of regular e-learning forums including one particularly for WBL providers, where you can meet up with other providers and share experiences.
